Summary

This is an inventory of non-stop transatlantic flights from Germany to the United States, based on information received from the airlines at the end of January or the beginning of February 2021. It is an indication of capacity using January 25th or February 5th as the sample date, unless otherwise stated. Please note that scheduled flights may change at short notice. See the airlines' websites for updates. While there are many direct flights with one stopover offered by U.S. and European carriers from Germany to the United States, this overview covers only non-stop flights.
